1) Introduction to SCSMS concepts as required by ISO 28000

3) Examination and certification

- The exam covers the following competence domains :
- Domain 1: Fundamental principles and concepts of supply chain security.
- Domain 2: Supply Chain Security Management System (SCSMS).
