The exam must be both scheduled and then taken online within 4 weeks following the start of your session.

1) Understanding Photoshop

- Overview of Photoshop.
- Digital images and colorimetry.
- Bridges and Mini Bridges.
- Photoshop tools: selection, text, hand, magnifying glass, gradient, corrector, eraser, airbrush, brush, stamp, etc.
- The crop tool and its many possibilities.
- Palettes: layers, shapes, channels, colors, etc.

2) Colors and images for the Web

- Light, color, additive synthesis (RGB) and subtractive synthesis (CMYK).
- Images for the Web.
- Preparing the photos: cropping by modifying the working area.
- Formats: PNG, GIF, JPG, animated GIF.

3) Correcting chromatic aberrations

- Brightness and contrast settings.
- Levels and curves.
- Color corrections (color balance, hue saturation, selective correction, etc.).

TRAINER QUALIFICATIONS

The experts leading the training are specialists in the covered subjects. They have been approved by our instructional teams for both their professional knowledge and their teaching ability, for each course they teach. They have at least five to ten years of experience in their field and hold (or have held) decision-making positions in companies.

ASSESSMENT TERMS

The trainer evaluates each participant's academic progress throughout the training using multiple choice, scenarios, hands-on work and more. Participants also complete a placement test before and after the course to measure the skills they've developed.

Hands-on work : Create a greeting card.

7) Creating and editing

- Colorations, text, and drawing and retouching tools.
- Transformations: symmetry, rotations, effects.
- Puppet warp.
- Missing content. Content-aware scaling.

Hands-on work : Create a banner from a photo that is not to scale.

8) Importing and exporting to the Web

- Export formats. Exporting in high resolution and for the Web.
- Printing, animation and palette editing.

Hands-on work : Create an animated GIF.
